1 - SNQ DISSEMINATION SEMINAR

DEVELOPMENT OF 9 DUAL-CERTIFICATE VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Within the scope of its remit, the National Qualifications Institute – INQ, in partnership with the Revitalisation of Technical Education and Vocational Training Project – RETFOP, with regard to transferring the methodology for drawing up professional qualifications, drew up 9 professional dual certification qualifications in November and December 2023, which are considered priorities for the labour market and are available in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications.

4 - SEMINAR TO DISSEMINATE THE NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS SYSTEM

THE INQ WILL HOLD SEMINARS ON 5, 7, 13, 19 AND 22 MARCH THIS YEAR TO DISSEMINATE THE NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS SYSTEM - SNQ AND PRESENT THE PROGRAMME FOR IMPLEMENTING THE PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS DRAWN UP.

The initiative aims to disseminate and train participants on the National Qualifications System and its instruments, as well as to present the programme for implementing the professional qualifications that have already been drawn up. The target audience will be managers and trainers from centres under the supervision of the National Institute for Employment and Vocational Training (INEFOP), managers from institutions linked to technical education and vocational training, representatives from RETFOP and other individuals.
